Nature of Work:

Under broad supervision, provide library materials and services to patrons who are unable to visit a library branch

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Drive Bookmobile and perform pre-and post-trip inspections (tires, generator, fuel, etc)

Report problems to management

Work with manager to schedule maintenance and/or repairs and keep records of same

Keep vehicle clean-inside and outside

Check materials out to patrons

Assist patrons with material selection

Re-shelve materials

Prepare route for bookmobile

Take patron requests

Hand-deliver materials to disabled patrons

Other duties as requested

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Must have valid Class D - Chauffeur's License or obtain license within 30 days of employment

(A driving record check will be performed on all employees driving Library vehicles)

Some knowledge of library procedures

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions

Ability to deal effectively with co-workers and the public

Flexibility with scheduling to maximize public service in spite of setbacks

Basic computer skills

Physical Requirements:

Work requires recurring standing, stooping, climbing, walking and lifting of items
